

Over a three year period, the Neighborhood Design Center will conduct a series visioning charrettes in three neighborhoods: Weinland Park, Near Southside, and King-Lincoln. The intent of the program is to create safer neighborhoods by increasing neighborhood engagement and sense of community identity, while identifying specific physical changes in the public realm that can increase individual and collective security. This study will be augmented by research, data compilation and synthesis, public meetings, and the drafting of conceptual designs. As a part of the final outcome, the Neighborhood Design Center will publish its findings graphically with text, while also presenting the results in a concluding public meeting.
